I like to burp!

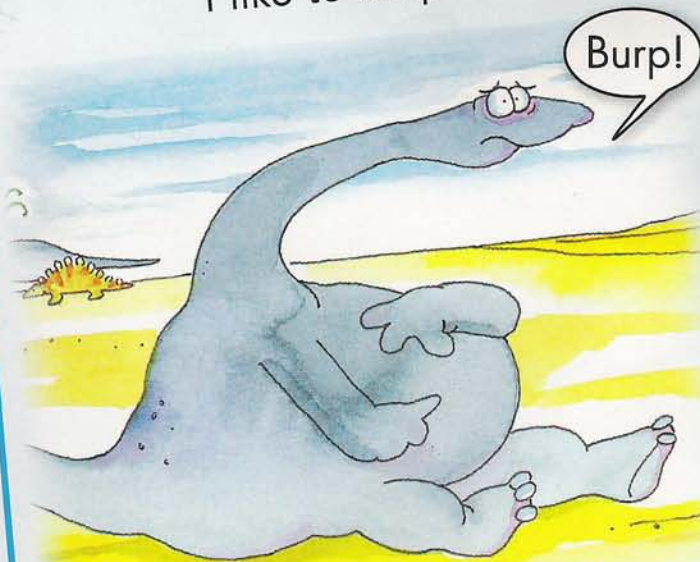
